Last Simchat Torah, we announced a special Kol Han'arim Project which will honor our children while creating a tangible reminder of their permanent bond to our Shul.

We have had the minhag in our Shul of using a Chupah for the aliyos of Kol Hanarim and chasanim on Simchas Torah. Last Simchat Torah, for the first time we used a new Chupah, a beautiful, new, large Tallis with Tzizzit specially designed, and supported by the usual four corner poles.
